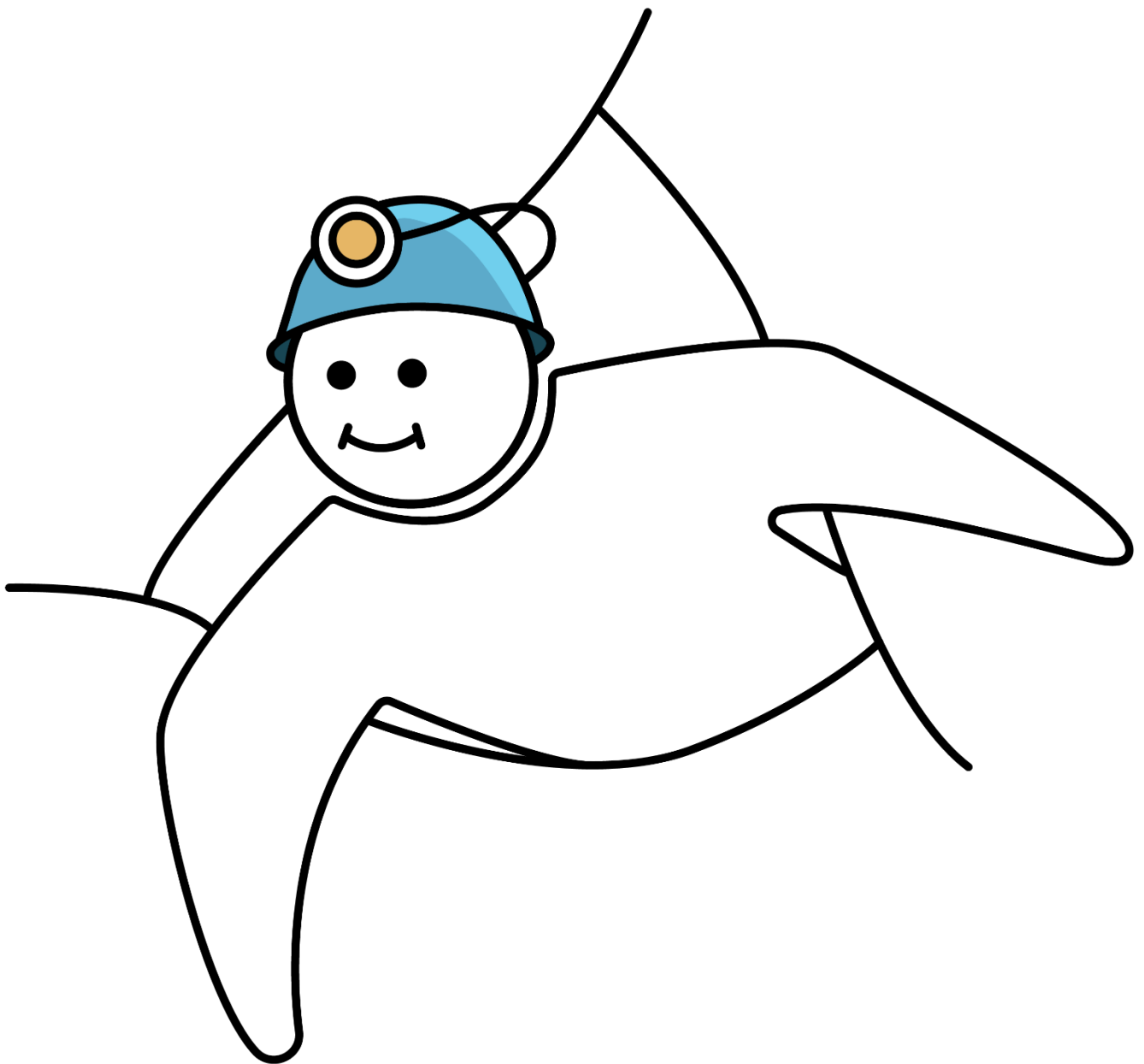


Indoor Caving



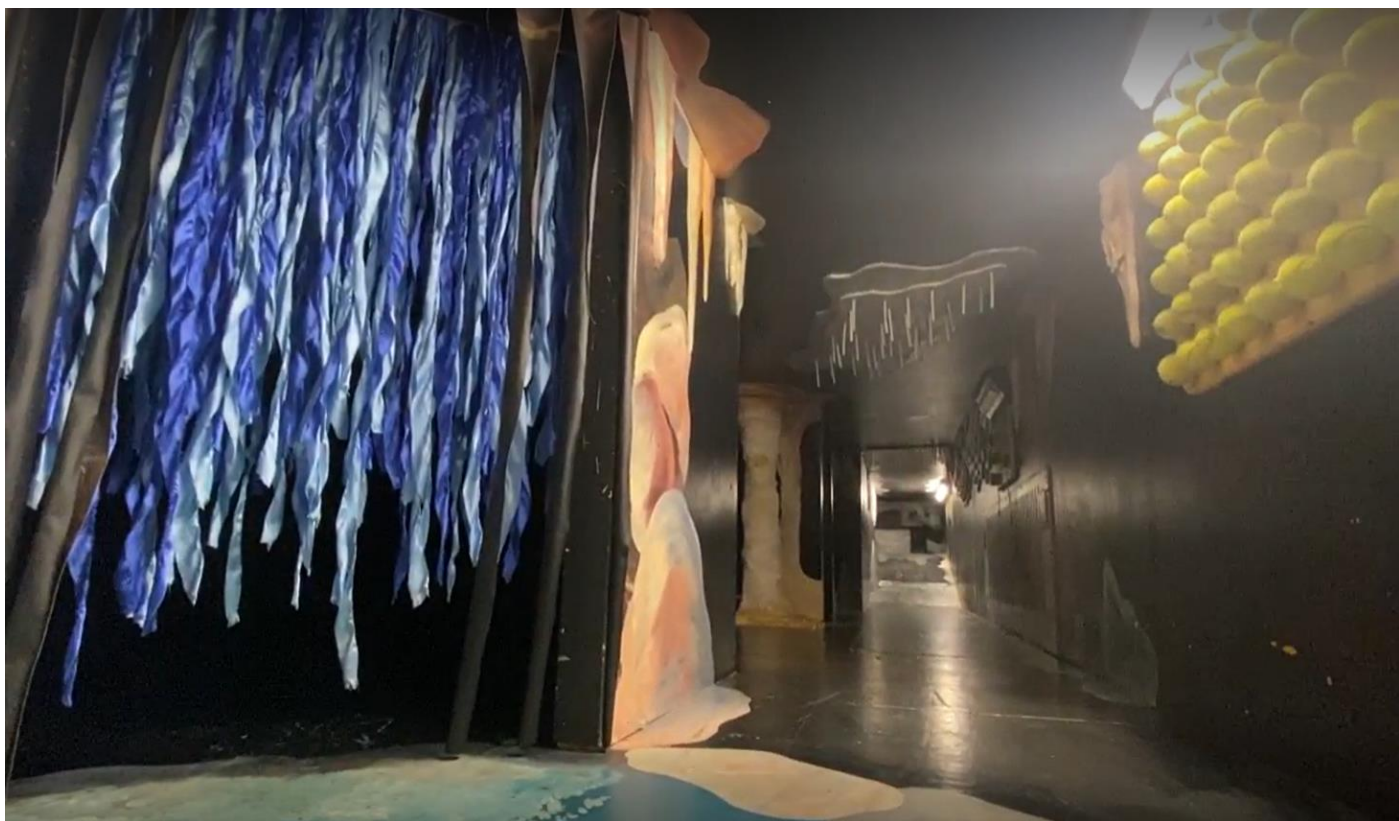
I am going indoor caving.

I will take off my shoes before going in the cave.

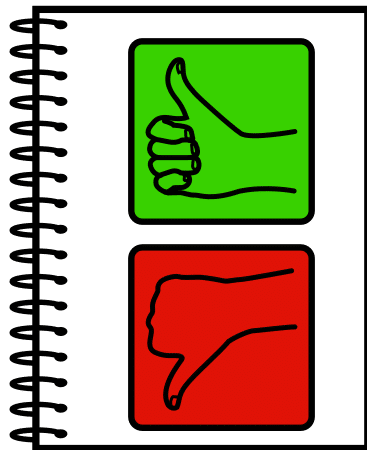
The cave is inside the building, and it is dry.

some parts are big.



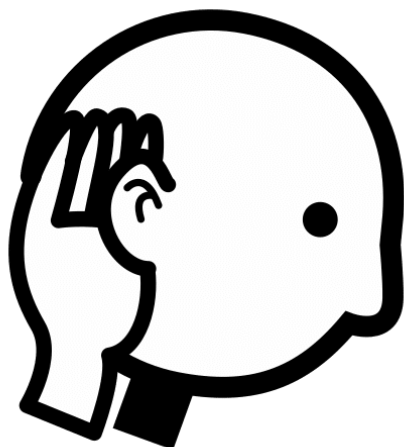
I will meet the Bendrigg tutor and other people. They will talk to me about the rules.

The cave can be dark or we can turn the main cave lights on.



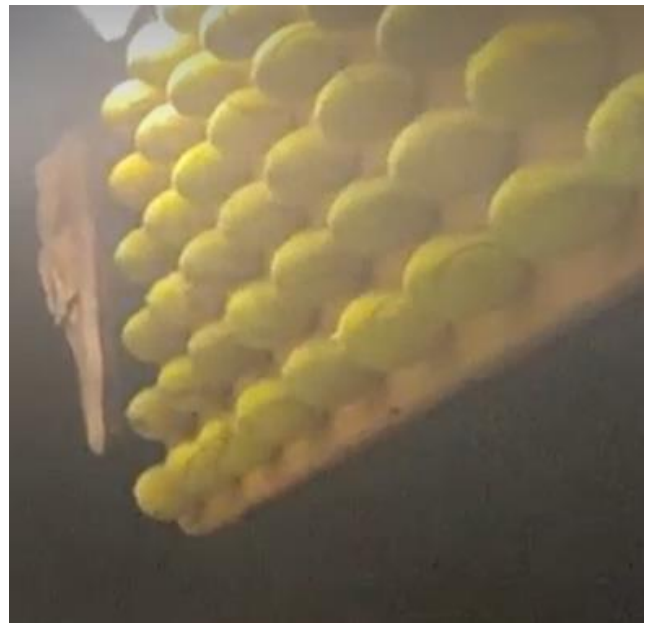
When it is my turn the Bendrigg tutor will ask me to go inside.

When I have finished caving I will turn the torch lights off and take off our helmets go and out of the cave.



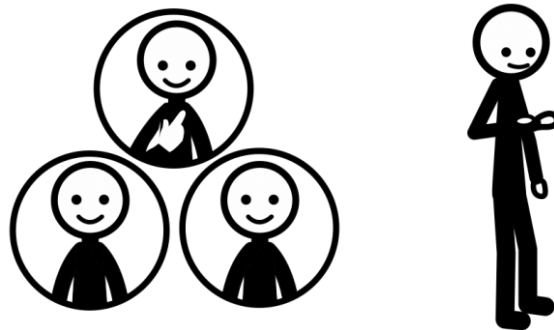
I can go out of the cave and put my shoes on.

I may be able to have another go.

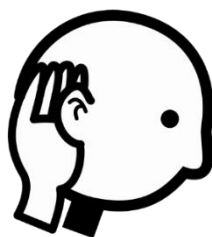
I will need to wait my turn.
