

## Sensory Swing

We will go to the sports hall in the Kinross building.




The sensory swing is a large swing attached to the roof of the hall.




I will sit in a seated harness and be swung around the space in the hall.

These are the ropes for the sensory swing.






I will meet the Bendrigg tutor and other people. They will talk to me about the rules.



This is to keep me safe.




I need to listen carefully.




I will need to sit and wait until it is my turn.

Then lift me in the harness.


## The swing can be fast or slow.

I may feel worried, this is okay.




I need to remember I am safe if we all listen carefully and follow the rules.
